03. RULES

The class eligible for the titled races is U.I.M CLASS 3C. The Championship will be held in accordance with rules of U.I.M and local organizer applicable for the year 2011. For rules not included in this program, the U.I.M's once will be applied. Rules and amendments of that kind, that may be issued within the jurisdiction of the Organizing Committee in i.e. the Race Instructions , Race briefings and Race Bulletins.

The Championship will comprise of the international three races series for the UIM OFFSHORE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS 3C 2011.

The races are approved by the U.I.M and SVERA. The races are arranged for power boats designed and built in accordance to the specifications for the Offshore Racing Class 3C. All race crafts must be measured, registered and approved by their applicable National Authority.

Race control, administration and inspections will all take place at the harbor of Oskarshamn, Sweden. The Organizing Committee reserves it's right to amend or modify the program for whatever reason they deem necessary at a given time.

For safety and media reasons the Organization Committee reserves the right to equip all boats with a GPS transponder for positioning and speed presentation on internet and/or on a large screens during and after the races including the official practices.

04. ENTRIES

The Entry is free of cost for all non Swedish competitors and must be sent to the Organizing Committee before 15th of May 2011. The Entry fee for Swedish competitors is 1 500 SEK and shall be transferred to Bankgiro 491-0261 latest 15th of June.

All competitors in the UIM OFFSHORE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS 3C must be approved by their National Authority. Overseas competitors must produce a written authorization from their National Authority, in order to participate in this Championship.

The Organizing Committee will reserve an area at the Pit for each registered and participating boat and their mobile repair unit and /or trailer/mobile home. The Organization Committee reserves it's right to appoint the area for each participating boat that is deemed to be most suitable.

Entry Form and Pit & Logistic Form are attached to this Advanced Program.

05. RACE INSTRUCTIONS

The Race Instructions will be available on 1st June 2011 and will be sent to all competitors (to competitors e-mail address in the Entry Form) that have had their entry accepted. Instructions will be available from the web site www.owc2011.com section "Race Instructions"

During the Administration Briefings, all official courses and information about the nautical points, buoy colors, start and finish, radio requirement will be advised of.

07. RACINGBOAT NUMBERS AND THEIR NATIONAL FLAG

The participant's boats must apply on the bow of the deck and on each board side, in a visible position, the racing number and the national flag, as indicated in the current U.I.M rule. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to require a number to be changed in the event of duplication of numbers being issued by different National Authorities. The organizing Committee has the right to affix on each competing boat the advertising Sticker of the event (U.I.M 203.6)

08. SAFETY

– Protecting Helmet

Any person aboard any boat crew taking part in the races and/or practice must wear an adequate and approved orange color helmet. The user is entirely responsible for the choice and efficiency of the helmet. Each crew member's helmet must be identified with their race boat number (UIM Rule 205.07)

– Racing Vest

Any person aboard any boat taking part in the races and/or practice must wear an efficient life jacket (racing vest). The choice and efficiency of the jacket is the sole responsibility of the user (U.I.M Rule 205.06)

– Equipment

During a race, the boat must have on board all the equipment as detailed in the U.I.M Offshore Rules.

09. FUEL

Fuel handling must be carried out in the designated fueling area, under supervision of a Pit Official. Failure to comply to this regulation may result in a fine of the discretion of the Race Committee.

95 and 98E Fuel can be purchased from most of the gas stations in Oskarshamn.

10. PROVISIONAL COURSES AND CHARTS

Bad weather courses may be decided by the Race Committee and will be communicated at Race Briefings and / or Race Bulletins.

The Oskarshamn no. 6241 sea chart is the only approved one for the U.I.M World Offshore Championship Class 3C. This sea chart can be purchased at the registration desk.

11. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The race committee cannot be held responsible for any accident/incident or any personal or other damage during competition and/or training.

All competitors must be properly insured for third party responsibility and against personal injury. Required third party insurance is minimum SEK 10,000,000. Insurance will be available from the organizer for SEK 700 per team. Request to use other insurance must be written in English and submitted in advance according to U.I.M. Rules.

12. PRIZES

The following will be awarded :

1st , 2nd and 3rd place trophies in each of the three races of the Championship

1st , 2nd, 3rd,4th and 5th overall World Championship trophies

13. PROTESTS

All protests and appeals are to comply with current UIM rules. All protests must be accompanied by a fee of 80 Euros that will be returned if the protest is upheld.

14. ADVERTISING

Tobacco and alcohol advertising is not permitted by a Swedish national law.

All boats will be requested to carry advertising decals. Details will be provided in the Race Instructions.
